Mr. Monahan works in the Maritime Engineering Program Management (MEPM) division in the Materiel Group as the Project Manager for the HALIFAX Class Modernization Frigate Life Extension (HCM FELEX) project. He is also the Major Surface Combatant Program Manager and is responsible to Director General Maritime Equipment Program Management (DGMEPM) for in-service management of the Halifax Class Frigate fleet.
